Can enjoy sex without desire

- Couples who delay sex until they feel urgent sexual desire may have infrequent sex
- Sexual arousal is separate from desire
- Can choose to engage in sex and enjoy arousal without first experiencing desire
- Must be <u>willing</u> to have sex

Reason + Willingness = Strong motivation to have sex

- Unwilling sex
 - Sympathy sex
 - Coercive sex
- Willingness to be sexual with or without desire
 - Promotes sexual pleasure
 - Builds the relationship
 - Fosters sexual interest
